- ⇒ Freedom is to be **expressed**.
2 Samuel 6:14-16; Galatians 5:1a
- ⇒ Freedom is to be **promoted**.
2 Samuel 6:17-20, Galatians 5:13
- ⇒ Freedom is to be **protected**.
2 Samuel 6:21-22, Galatians 5:1b
