His story is a picture of the life of every follower of Jesus...

***Big Idea: As one **covered** with grace,
I need to **extend** grace!***

Consider King David's interaction with Mephibosheth:

- ⇒ David, out of **love** for Jonathan,
demonstrates **grace** to his handicapped son.
2 Samuel 9:1-3; 2 Samuel 4:4; 1 Samuel 20:14-17
- ⇒ Mephibosheth was **hiding** when
King David **found** him.
2 Samuel 9:4-5
- ⇒ David took Mephibosheth from a place of
barrenness to a place of **honor**.
2 Samuel 9:6-10
- ⇒ David **adopted** Mephibosheth into his own family.
2 Samuel 9:11
- ⇒ Mephibosheth's disability was a **constant reminder**
of grace.
2 Samuel 9:13; 1 John 1:9

has covered my life with grace ...
I realize I don't deserve it, can't earn it, and won't ever repay it!
I realize I need to extend grace generously to others!**
