

Faith Works: Unwrapping the Gift Romans 3:21-31

At Easter, many children get baskets full of candy.
As sweet as that is, such gifts don't last.
Today's passage describes a gift that lasts forever ...
a gift you can't buy ...
a gift that each person must unwrap themselves...

Big Idea: It takes faith to unwrap the best gift ever!

Through Jesus Christ's resurrection you have been offered
the best gift ever. Unwrap it and discover that you are:

Given right standing with the Lord. verses 21-23

Declared just or innocent before the Lord. verse 24

Loved sacrificially by the Lord. verses 25-26a

Required to keep on having faith in the Lord. verses 26b -31

*Will you unwrap this gift by faith today?
If you already have unwrapped it,
the Lord wants you to continue celebrating it
and sharing it with others!*
