God's grace flows from heaven to earth. From there it flows into the life of every believer in Jesus Christ. Once God's grace enters our lives we have a decision to make: *Will I be a river or a reservoir?*

A river flows, a reservoir contains. A river moves, a reservoir remains. Like water, when grace stops flowing it becomes stagnant. So which am I – a river or reservoir? Our passage today shows us God's desired answer to that question.

Big Idea: God wants His grace to flow through me!

**As His grace flows through you,
He will help you overcome the challenge to:**

Live as a sacrifice. verses 1-2

Know my gift and use it. verses 3-8

Love others practically. verses 9-16

Honor even my enemies. verses 17-21

**In which of these areas does God's grace
need to flow more through me?**

Am I willing to let the Holy Spirit work through me?

Will I cooperate with Him?

Ask the Lord to do what only He can do through you!
