

ADULT SHORT-TERM MISSIONS TRIP

Location: Santiago, Dominican Republic

Date: It will be a 7-8 day trip in the time period of July 7-15

Cost: \$1,200 (includes the following: flight, transportation in country, accommodations, most meals, construction and ministry materials, VISA fee and an excursion).

*the above cost doesn't include the following: shots / passport fee, a few travel meals, and any souvenirs

Please note: The above estimate of \$1,200 is contingent on the fact that we can find reasonable flights

Passports: A passport must be obtained ASAP.

If you have a passport, check to be sure that it's valid.

If you need a passport, you can call Mary Beth @ the Trumbull County Clerk of Courts. Her number is (330) 675-3060. The passport fee is approximately \$100.00.

Note: It may be necessary to take malaria treatments as parts of Dominican Republic are prone to Malaria. You will be notified if this is necessary.

Training

Our training will include preparation for the various ministries including VBS type activities, cultural lessons, learning the language, praying together and team building initiatives.

Our training will begin in the spring (late February or March).

VISA

Once we land in the DR, we will purchase our VISA. This is included in total trip cost.

FUNDRAISING

Support Letters. Trip participants who need assistance are allowed to write support letters to family and friends inside and outside NMC. A total of 30 letters are allowed to be written by each participant. A sample letter will be provided by NMC.

PAYMENTS

You will be asked to make payments between the time that you register and our trip departure. This will help the cost of the trip to be broken down into smaller payments and also allow us to have money on hand to make flight reservations and pay for some in-country costs.

What will we be doing in the Dominican Republic?

Visiting children with Compassion International, spending time with missionaries, construction / minor repair projects, kid's ministries, sports ministry, visitation, prayer walking, orphanage visitation and evangelism. We will be partnering with some Christian & Missionary Alliance churches in the Santiago area.

How to Sign Up

1. Pray first and ask God if this is something that He wants you to do.
2. If God is leading you, fill out the Dominican Republic application form (on the missions table or at www.northmarchurch.com).
3. Submit application to parmitage@northmarchurch.com or drop off at church office with a non-refundable \$200.00 deposit by December 11th.
4. You will then be contacted regarding your application
