

WILD KINGDOM (3 YEARS)

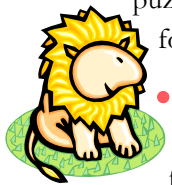
The wild kingdom roars with excitement from little tigers, lions and elephants on Sunday mornings!

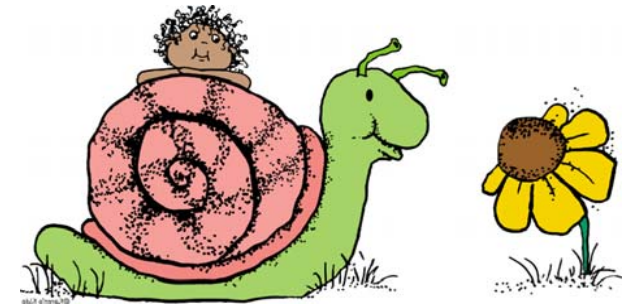

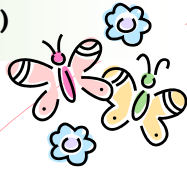

FLUTTER BUGS (0-12 MONTHS)



We are so glad to have your baby in our nursery! Be assured they will be well cared for and will have a pleasant time. Our Flutter Bug room is equipped with cribs, age-appropriate toys, bouncy seats, etc. for your baby's use.

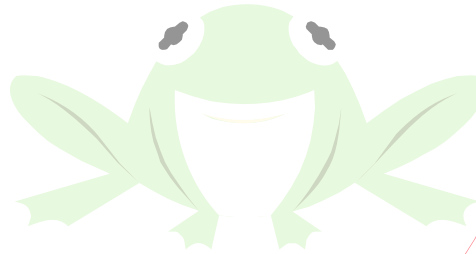
We do ask a few things from you, though, when dropping off your baby:

- Be sure you have filled out a registration form. Please sign in every week and during sign-in you will receive a vibrating pager. If, after 10 to 15 minutes, we are unable to calm your flutter bug, you will be paged.
- Please have their diaper bag clearly marked with their name and filled with any supplies a volunteer may need. Diapers and snacks from your bag only will be used, they are not provided.
- It is important for us to know of any specific instructions for your little one so please tell them to a nursery volunteer.
- We are germ-conscious and ask that if your baby is sick, or has been within the past 48-hours, please refrain from using the nursery. If a volunteer is not comfortable with the condition of your baby, you will be respectfully asked not to place them in the nursery.



LIL HOPPERS (13-24 MONTHS)

Our Lil Hoppers room is designed for toddlers between the ages of 13 and 24 months. Children develop at different rates and some may not be ready to change rooms at 13 or 24 months. We give age ranges for each nursery room, but it is ultimately up to the parents to decide when it is best to move your child to the next room.



Lil Hoppers will experience many activities while in the nursery:

- At the 9:30 service, a lesson is taught to the hoppers which includes an activity page and a take-home sheet for you to help your child take their first steps towards Jesus. The same volunteer teaches each week, ensuring your child sees a familiar face each visit.
- There is a wide variety of age-appropriate toys and books available for our volunteers to play with and read to the hoppers.
- Dairy-free and peanut-free snacks are also provided for your child.

GUPPIES (2 YEARS)



In 2007, our nursery suite was revamped to fit our ever-growing church family. We consider each child unique, therefore each room is uniquely designed for its age group.

Our Guppies room was designed with two year olds in mind:

- The guppies swim with their Sunday school to learn about Jesus. At the 9:30 service, the children are taught a Bible lesson from an age-specific curriculum, by the same teacher each week. For parents to continue lessons at home, take-home sheets are provided.
- Volunteers lead the guppies in songs and playing musical instruments.
- In addition to the lesson and song time, your guppy will have a coloring page, snack, and a wide range of toys to play with.
- Some two year olds are potty training and our volunteers want to work with you to facilitate this growing process. If your guppy is training, please take them to the restroom before dropping them off and let a volunteer know this information.
