

Soak the Church!

Romans 6:4

Today we are celebrating the two ordinances Jesus Christ gave to the Church – Communion and Baptism.

Both celebrations cause us to look back and consider what Jesus accomplished for us.

Communion recalls His actual sacrifice for us – His death and resurrection. Baptism recalls our response to His sacrifice, our decision to believe in Christ and what He accomplished for us through His death and resurrection – He gave us new life!

Romans 6:4: We were therefore buried with Him through baptism into death in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life.

Last week we studied baptism, and put forth a challenge to follow Christ in obedience by choosing baptism . . . Have you heard the news?

More than a 100 people responded and are being baptized!

So rather than just have one really long service, we are going to baptize people – young and old – all month long! Each Sunday in May, people will be telling their stories and testifying of their belief in Jesus Christ.

It is going to be a month of celebration as we “Soak the Church”!
